

Excerpts from Governor Pritzker's Order

Restrictions on travel

- All persons may leave their homes or place of residence only for Essential Activities, Essential Governmental Functions, or to operate Essential Businesses and Operations, all as defined below;
- May leave to perform work providing essential products and services at Essential Businesses or Operations (which, as defined below, includes Healthcare and Public Health Operations, Human Services Operations, Essential Governmental Functions, and Essential Infrastructure) or to otherwise carry out activities specifically permitted in this Executive Order, including Minimum Basic Operations;
- May leave the home to work for or obtain or Human Services Operations, including any provider funded by the Illinois Department of Human Services, Illinois Department of Children and Family Services, or Medicaid that is providing services to the public and including state-operated, institutional, or community-based settings providing human services to the public;
- All entities licensed pursuant to the Child Care Act, 225 ILCS 10, except for day care centers, day care homes, group day care homes, and day care centers licensed as specified in Section 12(s) of this Executive Order; residential settings and shelters for adults, seniors, children, and/or people with developmental disabilities, intellectual disabilities, substance use disorders, and/or mental illness; transitional facilities; home-based settings to provide services to individuals with physical, intellectual, and/or developmental disabilities, seniors, adults, and children; field offices that provide and help to determine eligibility for basic needs including food, cash assistance, medical coverage, child care, vocational services,

rehabilitation services; developmental centers; adoption agencies; businesses that provide food, shelter, and social services, and other necessities of life for economically disadvantaged individuals, individuals with physical, intellectual, and/or developmental disabilities, or otherwise needy individuals;

- May leave house to care for a family member, friend, or pet in another household, and to transport family members, friends, or pets.

Permitted-Essential Services and Businesses

- Businesses may continue operations consisting exclusively of employees or contractors performing activities at their own residences (i.e., working from home);
- Work providing essential products and services at Essential Businesses or Operations (Healthcare and Public Health Operations, Human Services Operations, Essential Governmental Functions, and Essential Infrastructure) or to otherwise carry out activities specifically permitted;
- Housing construction;
- Building management and maintenance (Association related services);
- cybersecurity operations;
- flood control;
- garbage;
- Internet, and telecommunications systems;
- Essential governmental services to provide for or support the health, safety and welfare of the public.
